Scholarship for Special Education Students

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Monday, January 15, 2018

About the Scholarship: Two (2) scholarships are presented annually. The scholarship, in the amount of \$3,000 per recipient, is paid in installments of \$1,500 for two (2) semesters. The funds must be claimed within a four (4) year period from the time the scholarship was awarded. Applications will be distributed to interested students by the University's Department of Special Education. Students will send applications directly to The Arc New York State Office.

About Joseph T. Weingold: This scholarship honors Joseph T. Weingold, first President and Executive Director of The Arc New York. Mr. Weingold was a pioneer in the field, significantly shaping the national policies on intellectual and developmental disabilities. Joseph T. Weingold was at the center of policy developments positively affecting the lives of people with I/DD in New York State and across the nation for four decades before retiring in 1980. Consistent with his belief that people with intellectual and other developmental disabilities should have a distinct legal status, he originated the concept of a separate state agency, now the Office for People with Developmental Disabilities, and became one of the primary founders of the national organization, The Arc.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Students must be enrolled in a New York State degree program, leading to a special education certification
- Students currently receiving a scholarship through The Arc New York are not eligible to receive simultaneous scholarships
- Upon selection, student must send confirmation of enrollment and course schedule

Application Requirements:

- Completed application
- Application must be signed by Department Chairperson
- One (1) letter of recommendation from a current academic instructor
